In conjunction with the Physical Resources department who updated the flooring, walls, and ceiling and a donor who contracted the services of a designer, the new Post-Operative (Post-Op) waiting room at The Moncton Hospital has been overhauled.

The Foundation was happy to provide the furnishings (*hospital-grade that meet current infection control standards*) and d ecor to complete this long overdue update.

Families and friends will find a calming and relaxed environment to help them bide their time as they wait for their loved one's surgical outcome.

This highly functional space boasts new modern furniture, artwork, USB charging stations for phones and tablets, and a large television and electric fireplace giving an inviting, comfortable ambiance.



A small kitchenette with a sink, ice maker and fridge is also available for use and of course a private bathroom as well.

Post-Op volunteers are over the moon with the newly renovated space. These volunteers are the liaisons between the medical staff and those waiting for updates on their loved one's surgeries.
