Monthly donation: The gift that keeps on giving

For years, **Vicki Bowie** has fought breast cancer -- her own and others' -- on two fronts.

First it was through rigorously sticking to an annual schedule of mammograms that the Riverview resident's breast cancer was first detected, what she calls five seconds of discomfort as part of doing "whatever it takes to get up each morning on the right side of the ground."

Second, through monthly giving to the Friends of The Moncton Hospital (TMH).

It was the mammogram just before Mother's Day 2021 that first detected a tumour. "Within three weeks of my diagnosis, I was in surgery."
